Minutes of the Ameraucana Breeders Club National Meet

10/14/06 - 2:45pm, recorded by Michael Muenks

The meeting was held adjacent to the show hall at the Frankenmuth Fowl Fest in Frankenmuth, MI. Attending the meeting were Curtis Beck, Barbara Campbell, Larry Clionsky, Jerry DeSmidt, Mike Gilbert, Michael Muenks, Bob Rennolet, Jerry Segler, Angela Smith, Paul Smith, Jeanie Trent, and Bob Walchak.

The meeting was called to order by Mike Gilbert. Mike Gilbert welcomed the club members on behalf of the North Central District and introductions were made. Mike Gilbert presented the minutes of the last meeting and the treasurer's report on behalf of Secretary/Treasurer John Blehm who was also the show superintendent.

Jerry DeSmidt made a motion to accept the minutes as presented and the quarterly treasurer's report from the fall bulletin and the motion was seconded by Bob Walchak. The motion carried.

Old Business:

1. ABA Portrait Project – There is only one Ameraucana picture in the new ABA Standard. The ABA declined the 2005 motion to split the cost of having a new correct portrait commissioned. Mike Gilbert will try to talk to Rusty at the America's National in Indianapolis to see if he would be will to paint new correct portraits for the club.

2. Qualifying New Varieties – Mike Gilbert reviewed the policies of the ABA and APA with the club membership regarding qualifying requirements for new varieties. The membership in attendance favored qualifying both large fowl and bantam at the same time. The current varieties in development are Splash, Splash Wheaten, Black Gold, Blue Silver, and Lavender. Splash and Splash Wheaten seem to have the most promise for a qualifying meet in the near future. Some organization needs to be done around qualifying Splash and Splash Wheaten so that members can raise enough for the meets. Members are encouraged to show varieties in development so that there is an official record of the variety and to create interest in the variety.

3. Silver Standard Revision – The subcommittee appointed at the 2005 club meeting recommended to move to the Silver Dutch description of the silver pullet/cockerel for the APA Standard. There was discussion of the lighter salmon breast color for the pullet and Golden/Silver verses Duckwing coloration. Larry Clionsky motioned to accept the Silver Dutch standard description for the APA Standard description of the Silver Ameraucana. Jerry Segler seconded the motion. The motion carried.

4. Exhibitor Point System – A brief discussion of the merits of a point system was presented and the idea was tabled. Currently any Junior is sent a rosette for best of breed regardless of membership in the ABC. Adults must be club members to receive rosettes.

New Business:

1. 2007 National Meet - The national meet for 2007 has not been placed by the board of directors. Bids are welcome and are due by November 15, 2006.

2. Bylaw Revisions – All revisions passed in the elections and go into effect January 1, 2007.

3. Election Results – There was only one contested race – Eastern Director, which was won by Rob Sando.

4. Other New Business – Jerry DeSmidt took charge of the Poultry Press ad for the club. The Lifetime Achievement Award was presented to Angela and Paul Smith.

Bob Rennolet motioned for the meeting to adjourn. The motion was seconded by Barbara Campbell. The motion carried.
