As the 2013 show season is starting to wind down, don't forget we still have two more meets in this district. The Ohio National (OH State Meet in Columbus) is scheduled for November 9-10, 2013 and whether you are exhibiting birds or not, it's still a great show to attend. Another upcoming poultry show you may want to consider is the ABA National & Dixie Classic in Knoxville, TN on December 7-8, 2013. The deadline to enter is November 15<sup>th</sup> - You can find out more about them on their website: http://tnvpoultryclub.com/

Next year (2014), the ABC National Meet rotates to the Eastern District and will be held during the Southern Ohio Poultry Association's Fall Show in Lucasville, OH on October 4th and 5th, 2014. The fall show this year (2013) had 2765 birds exhibited and they handed out close to \$3000 in prize money and awards. Their generosity did not stop there as they also furnished free coffee and donuts Saturday morning and then catered a free lunch for everyone at noon.

The ABC Eastern District Meet was held there this year with 11 exhibitors bringing in 31 Ameraucanas. Judging them were Matt Lhamon and Heather Hayes. In the Open, there were 13 LF in 4 different varieties. Matt Parker's beautiful white pullets took top honors by winning both the BB and RB. In the Open Bantam, 6 exhibitors brought 5 different varieties, with Nicole Pickard winning BB with her buff cockerel, and RB went to a blue wheaten cockerel that I was showing.



In the Junior classes, there were 4 bantams shown in 3 different varieties, with a black hen shown by Caleb Pickard winning BB and a buff pullet shown by Nicole Pickard winning RB. Also in the Junior class, there were 8 LF. Alexis Parker won RB with a white pullet, but also won BB with her white cockerel that then went on to win Champion AOSB and Champion Junior LF. Congratulations Miss Parker!

I am currently working on several projects that will help increase the Ameraucana Breeders Club's prize money and awards for our 2014 National Meet. I'm hoping to make it a very exciting and memorable

event for every exhibiting member and one you will not want to miss!
